Abstracts will be reviewed for scientific merit and EMS relevance. **It is acceptable to submit an abstract previously published within the last 12 months.** Case reports with high EMS Impact will also be considered. Notification of abstract acceptance will be announced October 31, 2017.

Recommended format for the abstract is as follows:

Title:

Authors:

Introduction: A brief description of why you performed this project (should also include your hypothesis)

Methods: How and what you actually did

Results: What you found

Conclusions: What does it mean?

Word count – maximum 350 words.
