Abstracts will be reviewed for scientific merit and EMS relevance. **It is acceptable to submit an abstract previously published within the last 12 months.** Case reports with high EMS Impact will also be considered. Notification of abstract acceptance will be announced October 31, 2019.

Recommended format for the abstract is as follows:

**Title:**

**Authors:**

**Background:** A brief description of why you performed this project (should also include your hypothesis)

**Methods:** How and what you actually did

**Results:** What you found

**Conclusions:** What does it mean?

Word count – maximum 2500 characters.
