Exhibitor Badge Rules

The following apply to all exhibitor personnel:

- Official show management badges must be worn at all times by exhibitor personnel while in the exhibit hall during move in, move out and official show hours.
- Exhibitor is responsible for ensuring badges are provided only to the company's personnel or authorized representatives required in the function of the exhibit space.
- Any false certification or deliberate misuse of exhibitor badges or will result in immediate removal from the exhibit hall of all parties involved.
- Stick-on novelty items are not permitted to obstruct visibility of the badge.
- Badges will only be released to the person whose name appears on the badge.
- Exhibitor will be responsible for securing badges for any hired personnel, including celebrities, temporary staff, entertainment staff, etc.
- Exhibitor badges may not be ordered for, or transferred to, attendees or non-employees.
- Complimentary Exhibitor Floor Badges are included with each booth space.
- Optional Exhibitor CE Badges allow exhibitors admission to full conference education sessions. These are available as an upgrade to any included Exhibitor Floor Badge for \$100.
- Additional Exhibitor Floor Badges are available for \$75. Additional Exhibitor CE Badges are available for \$175.
- Changes or substitutions for complimentary badges can be made through the online exhibitor registration system on or before November 12, 2021. Any requests after this date will be addressed onsite.
- Substitutions for booth personnel badges can be completed at no charge at onsite exhibitor registration. No substitutions can be made on badges that have already been used for admission. The lending/sharing of badges is prohibited and will result in confiscation.
- A \$10 non-refundable fee will be charged to replace a badge for any reason, including lost or stolen badges.

Please Note: In the interest of safety and injury prevention, children under 16 years of age will not be permitted on the exhibition floor during installation and dismantling of exhibits.
